Public art in public places is more than art it reflects the local environment and artistic vitality of the community. The Public Art Program was established in 1992 by municipal ordinance. Lynn showed slides of the libraries around the city. Each art project, whether a sculpted piece, a mural or a display was produced to capture the favor and heritage of the area. Some art is made to be climbed on. At the San Jose/Mineta Airport car rental building there is a very unique display of hands waving good-bye or hello. The models for the hands were people from the City in all walks of life. The Mural at our Berryessa Library was designed by a San Jose State graduate and a current resident. The Park behind Majestic Way Elementary School was constructed for use by the physically challenged. The art work consists of several 12 foot poles with facets attached that reflect light and create rainbows on the ground. The new Fire Station being built on Sierra Road and Piedmont Road will feature 2 columns called Guardians of the City. There will be 3 images made of steel that can be rotated around to create new images. The images will reflect cultural and gender diversity. People walking by will be able to create these images. 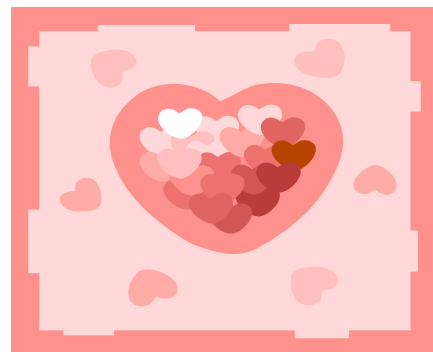
